

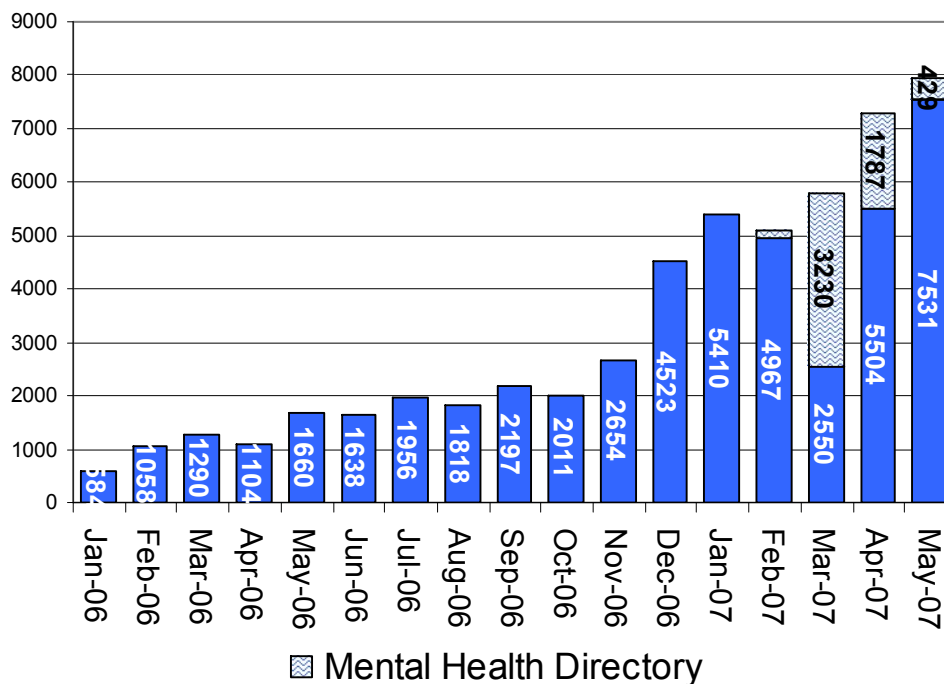
CEHI Weblog Activity Report – May 2007

CEHI's weblog offers a space on the internet for the local health community across South of Tyne and Wear which is accessible from homes, workplaces and community spaces such as libraries and community centres. Visitors to the site can search for information on a particular health topic, find out about recent local health development activities or contribute a “blog” about the work that they are doing.

The number of visits to the weblog has risen throughout 2006 and into 2007. In the most recent month, the site was accessed 8,000 times. This indicates that the community visiting the site is growing and that it is a site that people are returning to. There has been a recent emphasis on broadening the range of media used within the weblog. Visitors will have noticed the inclusion of podcasts and vodcasts (audio and video files which can be played or downloaded) including a video of a visit by local people with a learning disability to meet the Secretary of Health in London. 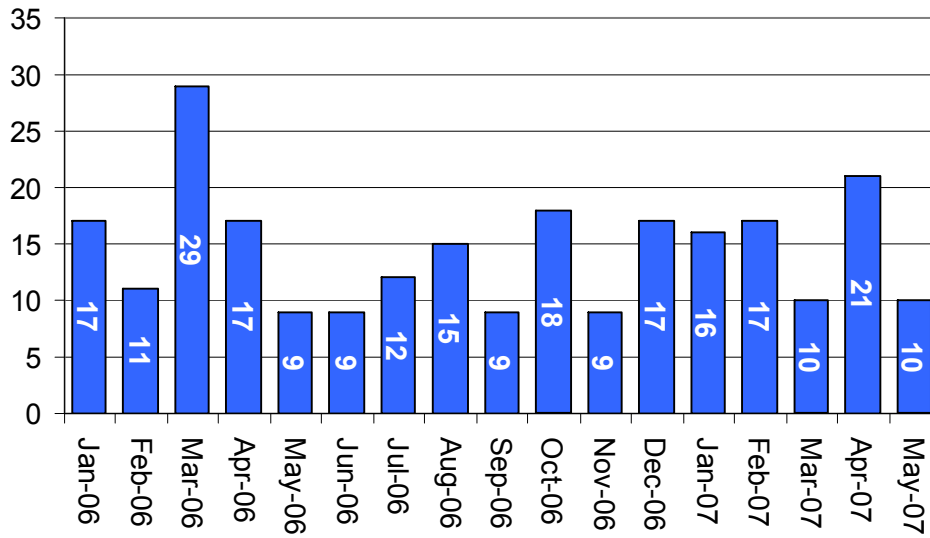
